Matthew 6:19-24

“Kingdom Treasure”

*“For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.” Matthew 6:21*

- 1) How do you decide what is valuable? What would you consider to be your top three priorities?
- 2) Why does Jesus ask us “Where is your heart with God?” throughout the Sermon on the Mount?
- 3) Why does Jesus focus on the “heart” rather than the mind or body or soul?
- 4) What things on earth are seen as “treasures”? What is the treasure of the “kingdom of heaven”?
- 5) Why does Jesus tell us we must seek kingdom of heaven treasures over earthly treasures?
- 6) What would be seen as your greatest treasure - by looking at your checkbook and your calendar?
- 7) What is the danger of valuing things on earth that make us feel happy and secure?
- 8) How does seeking the treasures of money, time, possessions or position will blur our spiritual vision?
- 9) Why can we not serve ourselves both with treasures on earth and with treasures in heaven?
- 10) What is the greatest, most valuable, worthy, glorious, eternal treasure our hearts could ever know?
