What kind of judgment is good? Why?
- 3) How can we view and treat others who sin with a humble spirit of grace rather than with a spirit of condemnation?
- 4) What fuels our desire and ability to be humble in how we treat others?
- 5) How does the forgiveness shown to us in Jesus help us to be forgiving people?
What does it look like for us to live in this way?
- 6) Why is “log removal” needed in order for us to help a brother or sister remove the sin in his or her life?
How have you seen this at work before?
- 7) How have you been helped by a brother or sister who once “walked in your shoes”?
- 8) Why is discernment necessary regarding who we invest in?
Why might this be seen as the exception rather than the rule when it comes to both evangelism and discipleship?
