Acts 4:32-37

“The Testimony of Unity”

- 1) Why can we be so quick to focus on our differences rather than our similarities?
- 2) Verse 32 shows us that the believers in Acts “were of one heart and soul.” What might that look like for us at Arrowsmith Baptist Church?

What steps can we take to focus more intently on our unity in Christ?

- 3) How can we live as a church so that we have “everything in common” (v32) and take care of each other?

What kind of sacrifices would it take for us to love each other in this way?

- 4) How does disunity in the church hurt our witness to the world?

How does unity in the church help our witness to the world?

- 5) Verse 33 shows us that the believers in the church in Acts were “giving their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus.” How does unity in Christ and love for each other bear witness to the risen Jesus?

What things can we share with others who notice our unity in Christ and love for each other?

- 6) How would you like others to pray for you so that you can be more intentional in loving your brothers and sisters in Christ?

How would you like others to pray for you so that you can share the good news of our risen Savior, Jesus?
