- 4) How can we attempt to be more relatable to others in the way we share Christ, while staying faithful to the Biblical gospel message of life in Jesus Christ?

How have you seen others do this well? How has God done this in times you have witnessed to others?

- 5) Do we expect to face opposition as Christians? Why or why not?

How can we prepare ourselves for opposition we will face in living for Christ?

- 6) How might we stay faithful in preaching the Gospel in the midst of opposition?

- 7) How does it encourage you to know that so many others face opposition while living for Jesus?
