1. As you think in terms of the above scenario: (12 minutes)

How would you, and should you, change the pattern of sharing the gospel from Acts 11:19, to 11:20? *Acts 11:19* Now, those who had been scattered by the persecution that broke out when Stephen was killed travelled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus and Antioch, spreading the word only among Jews. ²⁰ Some of them, however, men from Cyprus and Cyrene, went to Antioch and began to speak to Greeks also (Antioch was made of all cultures in western part of the Roman empire) telling them the good news about the Lord Jesus.

What is God saying to you about bringing the gospel to your part of BC?

2. Chose an option below for your break-out group (15 minutes)

II Cor. 5:16-21 teaches about being ambassadors of reconciliation. In super-diversity, there are many national/ tribal histories, all contaminated by sin and war. How might we become reconcilers between humanity's diversity to reconcile neighbours to God?
